BPS will be removing funding from an overbudgeted previously approved activity of the Math instructional coaches to fund positions in the summer of SY23 & SY24 to coordinate the plethora of student activities we will be having on our campuses. Since we first submitted our ARP Plan, two of the contracted day schools we were funding have closed down and terminated services. The funds that we previously allocated to these schools will be used to fund the new school we began to service the students previously serviced by those contracted schools. The decrease of funds will remain in the respective Activities for Learning Loss and General Fund.

BPS will be diverting previously approved funds for the outdoor classrooms to a different funding source and will reallocate those funds into the previously approved activity of carpet replacement in high risk areas. This is to increase air quality in our schools and other locations to decrease hazardous conditions and the spread of COVID 19.
